#### SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

The usual precautions for handling chemicals should be applied. In case of any symptoms of concern – call medical help. NEVER induce vomiting in an unconscious person.

##### 4.1 Description of first aid measures.

INHALANTION:	Remove from exposure to fresh air immediately. In case of lack of breathing, apply artificial respiration. Get medical aid if cough or other symptoms appear.
SKIN CONTACT:	Wash with water and soap. Remove contaminated clothes. If irritation persists or any tissue damage effect is apparent, obtain medical advice.

## SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

### 6.1 Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures.

#### For non-emergency personnel:

Limit the access for the outsiders into the breakdown area, until the suitable cleaning operations are completed. In case of large spills, isolate the exposed area. Ensure adequate ventilation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid contact with spilled material. Danger of slipping, do not pass through spilled material. Wear adequate personal protective equipment (overalls, rubber gloves, safety glasses and half mask with AX filter). Do not allow the product to get into mouth.

#### For emergency responders:

If specialised clothing is required to deal with the spillage, take note of any information in Section 8. Suitable and unsuitable materials See Section 10.5. See also the information in "For non-emergency personnel".

### 6.2 Environmental precautions.

In case of release of large amounts of the product, it is necessary to take appropriate steps to prevent it from spreading into the environment. Notify relevant emergency services. Protect drain wells against getting the mixture into the water and sewage system.

### 6.3 Methods and material for containment and cleaning up.

Remove all sources of ignition. Secure damaged packaging. Soak up with liquid-binding material (e.g. sand, universal binding agent, diatomaceous earth). Collect spilled material in containers. Disposal in accordance with the local legislation. Small amounts of the remaining mixture should be flushed down the drain with plenty of water. Clean the contamination place with detergents.

### 7.1 Precautions for safe handling.
