## SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

The usual precautions for handling chemicals should be applied. In case of any symptoms of concern – call medical help. NEVER induce vomiting in an unconscious person.

### 4.1 Description of first aid measures

INHALANTION:	Remove from exposure to fresh air immediately. In case of lack of breathing, apply artificial respiration. Get medical aid if cough or other symptoms appear. Provide peace and protect against heat loss.
SKIN CONTACT:	Wash with water and soap. Remove contaminated clothes. If irritation persists or any tissue damage effect is apparent, obtain medical advice.

#### For non-emergency personnel:

Limit the access for the outsiders into the breakdown area, until the suitable cleaning operations are completed. In case of large spills, isolate the exposed area. Ensure adequate ventilation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid contact with spilled material. Danger of slipping, do not pass through spilled material.

Wear adequate personal protective equipment. Do not allow the product to get into mouth.

### 6.3 Methods and material for containment and cleaning up.

Remove all sources of ignition. Secure damaged packaging. Absorb the spilled product by sprinkling with a binding agent material (earth, dry sand, diatomite) and transfer to tightly closed replacement containers and send for destruction.

Small amounts of the remaining mixture should be flushed down the drain with plenty of water. Use detergents for cleaning.
